ORDINANCE NO. 18-1009

ESTABLISHING A NO SIGN PERIMETER AT THE VETERAN'S MEMORIAL

Upon motion by Magistrate Teresa Hamlett seconded by Magistrate Kenny Scott and ~~unanimously~~ adopted, the Fiscal Court of Metcalfe County, Kentucky does hereby ordain as follows:

WHEREAS, the County of Metcalfe has a Veteran's Memorial in the courthouse yard on the public square of Edmonton; and,


WHEREAS, the County has renovated the area around the Veteran's Memorial, and,

WHEREAS, the County wishes to honor its Veteran's with an unobstructed view of said memorial; and

WHEREAS, the placing of signs and other advertisements in and around said memorial diminishes the honor and beauty:


NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Fiscal Court of Metcalfe County that all signs, advertisements or any other obstructions are prohibited in front of and for 60 feet each side of, the Veteran's Memorial located in the corner of the courthouse square specifically at the corner of Main and Stockton Street, Edmonton, Metcalfe County, Kentucky. This prohibition shall began at the entrance to said memorial and extend 60 feet south on Main Street and 60 feet east on Stockton Street including any and all sidewalks therein.
